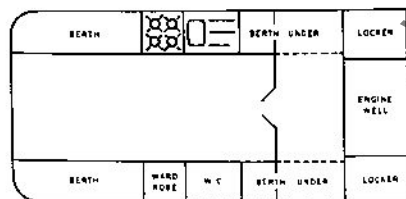

Builders comments

In Dandy we have a small cruiser where, by a clever use of space, many of the features of larger boats have been incorporated. There are four full berths in the cabin, a galley with full headroom, containing a sink, drainer and a full size cooker, a toilet and wardrobe, and sufficient cupboard space to hold all that you would want for a fortnights cruise. The tunnel which runs most of the boats length means that you only need a short shaft engine, which allows you to run in very shallow water. The twin sponsons add the stability of catamaran to an already stable boat and the multi-shaped bows give a soft ride in rough weather.
