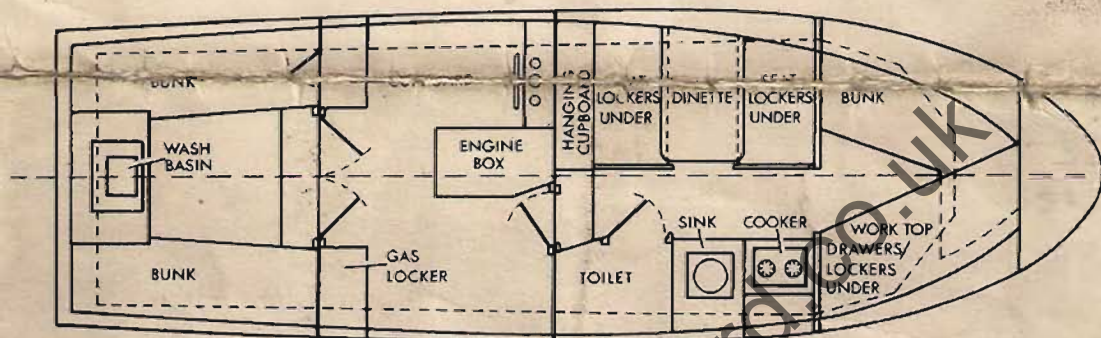
Some details you'll appreciate.

The forward cabin sleeps three. It also contains a dinette, well-equipped galley (oven/cooker), hanging cupboard and plenty of storage space. The toilet compartment is separate. Work surfaces on table top and dresser are laminated plastic. Cabin sides are lined with waterproof plywood. The centre cockpit which separates the forward from the after cabin provides excellent visibility. The 'guest' cabin aft, has two single bunks and a fitted washbasin. The cruiser is carpeted and curtained throughout and fully provided with cushions.

Your power options

Either single or twin Perkins 4-107 diesel engines with hydraulic gearbox, single lever control, heat exchanger and 2:1 reduction.
