Construction

- White GRP hull and superstructure with blue decals
- Blue acrylic cockpit canopy in 2 parts
- aluminium and PVC upper rubbing strakes
- Integral GRP bathing platform
- Hinged radar arch - reduces air draft

Engine

- Twin Volvo AQ131A 4 cylinder petrols
- Volvo outdrives
- 3x12v batteries
- Single lever controls

Accommodation

- U shaped seating/2 single berths
- Removable dining table
- Toilet to starboard
- Door aft leads to quarter berth under cockpit
- Headlinings and sidelinings in cream vinyl
- Timberwork in oiled teak ply

Galley

- Stainless steel sink with hot and cold water supply supplied by calorifier from engine
- Electric fridge
- Gas 2 ring grill oven cooker

Toilet

- Vanity basin
- Shower
- Manual flush sea toilet

Cockpit

- Bench seating pulls out to create a double berth/sun lounger
- Triple helm seat to starboard - folds back to create social seating
