


## Manufacturer/model: Seamaster / Seamaster 813

- BMC 4 cylinder dieel engine
- Conventional shaft drive
- Single lever control
- 2 x 12 volt batteries
- Shore Power
- Battery charger

### Accommodation

- Separate forward cabin
- 2 v berths
- Infill panel converts to double berth
- Table dinette to port
- Table drops down to form double berth
- Galley to starboard
- Toilet compartment to starboard
- Door and hatch to cockpit
- Timberwork in teak plys
- Carpets and curtais to match


- Sea toilet to port

- Stainless steel sink
- Hot water via calorifier from engine
- 2 ring,grill,oven cooker

- Helm position and seat to port
- Na seat to starboard
- Bench seat aft
- Access to engine under floor
- Upholstery in whitevinyl
- 12v fridge
