
Cruising in effortless luxury can be one of life's finest experiences.






- A Cockpit showing Helm & crew seating

Ocean 30 Hardtop


Ideal for offshore cruising, the hardtop provides protection for the crew against inclement weather conditions, and at the same time the good lines reduce wind resistance.

Side curtains can be rolled down to create a large comfortable cockpit wheelhouse.


Ocean 30 Folding Canopy



An added advantage is the adaptability of the large cockpit area for sunbathing.





















Stern view showing allweather canopy

G.R.P. is now long proven and provides the owner with a boat that requires a minimum of upkeep, no hull maintenance, minimum depreciation, withstands abrasion, has high impact resistance and is treated to obviate condensation.

In keeping with our policy of building with the finest materials available, the Mercedes-Benz OM636 four cylinder diesel engines are fitted as standard providing the owner with the utmost reliability, economy, exceptionally quiet performance and the knowledge that with the worldwide Mercedes Benz spares and after-sales service his craft will at all times be maintained to the highest standards.





Ocean 30's accommodation layout dependent on type of layout from Aft Cockpit or Aft Cabin.


Galley has a combination stainless steel sink grill unit with built in oven and associated with much larger craft. refrigerator. Plenty of storage space to

hand is provided, and all work surfaces provides for up to six adults in comfort, have durable and easy to clean covering.

Toilet and shower compartment, with its G.R.P. mouldings and laminated bulkhead, gives the sort of space usually

wrap-round settee or dinette with settee on starboard side. All appointed with a top quality cloth of the customers choice.

A generous Cocktail Cabinet, richly carpeted cabin floor and large windows for excellent vision, add to your complete enjoyment of the boat.



GENERAL SPECIFICATION

Measurements: L.O.A. 29' 9" (9.2 m). L.W.L. 27' 9" (8.3 m). Beam 10' 2" (3.1 m). Draft 2' 6" (0.75 m). Weight (hull) 1800 lbs (813 kg).

Hull: GRP A/F hull moulded by Aqua-Fibre Ltd. Lloyd's certificate can be supplied at extra cost.

Superstructure: Self-coloured one-piece moulding by Aqua-Fibre Ltd.

Engines: Twin Mercedes-Benz OM 636 4 cyl. 42 h.p. diesels. PERKINS 4/108 engines can be fitted as an alternative.

Gear Boxes: 2.1.1. reduction.

Instruments: One set per engine. Water temperature gauge. Tachometer. Ammeter. Engine oil pressure gauge. Gearbox pressure gauge. Fuel gauge. Ignition switches. Engine stop control.

Engine Bearers: Mild steel angle fastened to engine beds with high tensile steel bolts.

Propeller Shafts: Stainless steel.

Propellers: Twin, manganese-bronze.

"A" Brackets: Manganese-bronze.

Rudders: Twin, manganese-bronze.

Steering: Rack and cable assembly fitted inside instrument

console, with 18" spoked wheel.

Fuel Tank: Twin engine - one of 70 gals.

Water Tank: 55 gals.

Engine Room Ventilation: Extraction fan.

Windows: Toughened glass in anodised alloy frames, doubledrop panes to Port and Starboard in Main Saloon. Single drop panes in forward cabin.

Engine Room: Fully noise-insulated.

Hot Water: Supplied by calorifier fitted to engine; fully insulated 12 gal. tank.

Lights: Two forward berth lamps, one Moonstone toilet lamp, two 12 strip saloon lights, one cockpit light, and one light over galley sink.

Bilge Pump: Manual 10 gals, per min. gusher.

Electrical System: 12v throughout; one 12v heavy duty

battery to each engine.

Bulkheads: Selected veneers (Sapele).

Accommodation: Galley sink unit with combination stainless steel sink, hotplate and grill unit; adequate stowage and cupboards; Opela taps (h. & c.). Calor gas oven. 1 cu. ft. gas refrigerator fitted with safety cock, and built-in safety device.

Main Saloon: Full length single settee/birth. Raised dinette with settees/double berth in marine quality Vinyl (range of colours available). Neat folding table. Cocktail cabinet Hanging wardrobe. Flooring covered with deep pile foambacked carpet (as in all cabins and saloons). Pelmets fitted to all curtained windows; silent anodised alloy curtain track. Cabin sides foam lined, and covered with first quality Torino Lionide to obviate condensation. Head lining is of perforated Melvina, with anti-condensation barrier. Curtains in first quality folk-weave material, fully-lined; choice of patterns. White tumbler switches. All joinery in Sapele finish high gloss polyurethane varnish. Generous storage space.

Toilet Compartment: Self-coloured pink GRP vanitory unit fitted with two Opela taps, shower with mixer, shower tray. Two mirrors, 48" x 12" and 20" x 14". Portaflush-toilet. Panelled toilet lining with choice of Melamine laminates; head lining in white glaze. Moonstone lamp. Door furniture in chrome. Electric shaver plug. Shelves fitted with fiddle rail under vanitory sink unit.

Forward Cabin. Safety ventilated/escape hatch. Two single berths; mattresses in 5" foam and latex covered in marine quality Vinyl. Leeboards in Sapele with two storage drawers under, bull panelling foam-backed buttoned Vinyl. Windows, curtains, and floor as in Main Saloon. Side and head linings as in Main Saloon. Hanging cupboard with clothes rail.

Cockpit/Wheelhouse: Choice of rigid or folding windscreen, both of toughened glass with anodised moulded frame. Two fully removable engine hatches. Folding helmsman's seat. Instruments set in black GRP steering console. All switches water-proof marine type. Windscreen wipers. Cockpit courtesy light. Weather-proof PVC cockpit folding canopy. Floor covering — simulated teak. Non-slip decking.

Deck Fittings: Stainless steel pulpit. Stemhead roller. Bolt bollards. Fender eyes. Alligator extractor vent. Mahogany handrails on chrome stanchions on cabin top and superstructure side. Fenders. Warps. Boat hook. Ensign flag-staff. Anchor, 3 fathoms 5/16" chain, 12 fathoms nylon and hawse pipe. Raked folding mast and stays. Dry powder fire extinguisher. Twin chrome horns. Navigation lights. High power searchlight. Steaming and masthead light. Compass. Echo sounder.

General: Calor gas — sealed in metal container draining overboard with $\frac{1}{2}$ drain — two x 10 lb. with regulator, located aft, with isolating cock installed above waterline. The whole installation carried out to the Thames Conservancy Board regulations.

Colours: Hull and Superstructure: White (standard), or special

to customer's choice, at additional cost.

Louvres: To customer's choice.

Toilet: Basin and some pink, or to choice. Bulkheads: Beige marble, or to choice.

Cabin: Natural wood — Sapele. Working surfaces — Sapele Melamine. Head lining — white perforated Melvina. Hull lining — Ivory. Mattresses, cushions, etc. to customer's requirements.
