


A Princess in the family rapidly transforms your life style . . . every moment of leisure time takes on an entirely new value and enjoyment potential. The 25 is currently the junior member of the famous Princess range—yet displays very precocious ideas on accommodation and performance. Within compact dimensions you will find every essential for enjoyable cruising: a spacious cockpit, four berths in an ingenious two-cabin layout, a properly-equipped galley, a separate toilet compartment and ample stowage. Performance and handling are big league, too . . . up to 30 knots from single or twin petrol or diesel engines—plus excellent high-speed stability from the modified vee-form hull and beamy radiused aft section.

Inshore, the 25 displays amazing agility in crowded or shallow waters and can be beached without damage to sterngear. Offshore the strongly built and well designed hull looks after both safety and ride comfort, right through the speed range.

As the Princess 25 is designed to increase your off-duty pleasures rather than your off-duty duties, maintenance requirements have been reduced to a minimum by the clever use of high quality g.r.p. throughout the boat. But your best guarantee of carefree cruising is the care and thought we have already put into all aspects of building and design . . . the Princess may have that expensive feel about her, but she still retains very commonsense ideas about price.



If a spacious feeling within limited dimensions is the mark of clever interior layout, we feel our designer has really earned his laurels on the Princess 25. The starboard galley is fitted with a stainless steel sink, gas cooker with two burners and grill and ample stowage racks for food and utensils. A hanging locker is fitted aft of the dinette unit and there is further stowage beneath the berths.


The roomy self-draining cockpit welcomes sunlovers with a full width upholstered aft seat, well protected by ample coamings. The helmsman enjoys

excellent all-round vision and single-lever fingertip control from his protected position in a framed shelter of rigid alloy. (A sunroof may be specified as an optional extra.)


The forward cabin, which can be separated from the main cabin by folding double doors, is fitted with generous-sized single berths. The plan overleaf shows how these are cleverly incorporated into a seating plan for six or seven when a single open plan saloon is formed by folding back the doors.

The above plan shows the general layout including the large size dinette arrangement in the main saloon, with folding table, which converts to a comfortable double berth for night-time use. The cockpit is moulded in g.r.p. for easy maintenance and has an integral non-slip deck. There is sizeable stowage space beneath the cockpit floor.
