The 813 is the perfect choice for the modern family who like a cruising holiday but don't want to rough it. Within an 8.13 metre length, there's luxurious accommodation for four adults in a boat that's both easy and pleasant to handle.

Inside and out particular attention has been taken to achieve the look of today. The moderately veed hull in finest fibre glass has sleek modern lines and attractive wide sidedecks. The foredeck provides generous space for sunbathing, while below decks the luxurious interior includes panelling in decorative ply.

Let's take a closer look at the reasons that make the 813 the boat you'll want to own.

So many features you'll like

With some boats you have to crouch and creep about. But not with the 813. There's 6'0" headroom throughout. Both cabins are fully carpeted and the large windows are curtained. Accommodation in the forward cabin consists of two single berths, while in the main cabin the dinette has a folding and lowering table so that a double berth can be made up at night.

The main cabin also contains the well-equipped galley, which will delight women members of the party. There is a stainless steel sink with hot and cold water, two-burner cooker, grill and oven, and electric refrigerator. Working surfaces are Melamine covered and there is ample stowage and cupboard space for food and crockery.

Large private toilet compartment

Specially important for a family boat, is the large toilet compartment between the main and forward cabins, which is fully private and can be shut off completely from either cabin. It also contain its own ceramic basin (with hot and cold water supply), shower and mirror.

Spaciously designed cockpit

The cockpit 2.69 m long (8' 10") gives passengers plenty of room to move about in comfort. Hood and side curtains are provided for wet or stormy weather. The helmsman has his own individual cushioned seat at the controls which makes the boat easy and pleasant to handle even in crowded waters.

A mate's seat is fitted on the starboard side.

Your choice of engines

1600 cc Wortham Blake/Ford Fisherboy Four single/twin petrol engine(s), or Wortham Blake/B.L.M.C. Fisherboy 1.5 diesel engine(s). All engines have single lever control and instruments grouped at the helm, including twin windscreen wipers and echo sounder.

cut off) and fiddle rail. Calor gas tank to take two 10 lb bottles.

TV point and shaver point fitted.

Hanging cupboard. Drinks cupboard. Tumbler rack.

Crockery stowage. Drawers and cupboards.

Carpets, cushions and curtains fitted.

Melamine covered working surfaces and dinette table.











1 & 2. Saloon.

The large dinette table seats all crew without crowding. When not in use it can be folded away and can be lowered at night when the double berth is required. The saloon itself is beautifully finished in oiled teak and decorative ply with a choice of soft furnishings.

3 & 4. Toilet compartment.

Particularly spacrous for a boat of this size, the toilet compartment can be shut off completely from both the fore and main cabins. The chemical toilet is on the port side and on the starboard side is a ceramic basin with pressurised hot and cold water supply. There is also a large mirror.

5. Galley.

The attractive galley is well-equipped with stainless steel sink and hot and cold water, two-burner cooker grill and oven. There is plenty of storage space for food, crockery etc. and a generous drinks and hanging cupboard as well.

6. Cockpit.

Spacious and delightful enough for open air meals as well as for enjoying the passing scene. Fitted helmsman's seat for accurate manoeuvring. Hood and side curtains for wet weather protection. Instruments and controls grouped conveniently to hand.
