

With deep-veed hull, hard chine and extra wide 10'2''beam, the new, gracefully proportioned Seamaster 820 has been designed with safety, stability and comfort uppermost in mind, making it the ideal 4-berth family cruiser for both inland and offshore waters.

The wide side decks, roomy foredeck, big coach roof and huge cockpit/wheelhouse provide ample space for fine weather relaxation, while down below the luxurious, open plan accommodation helps turn dull days into fun days.

Like all Seamaster cruisers, the 820 is craftsman built to exceptionally high standards. The extremely strong hull, superstructure and helmsman's shelter are in re-inforced GRP—the colour scheme is white with a distinctive coloured sheer band. Naturally, all open deck areas have non-slip surfaces.

In front of the helmsman's seat is the bridge console with its single lever controls, teleflex-operated steering and all instruments. Fuses and battery switches are enclosed in the console behind a removable panel for easy accessibility. The passenger/lookout seat is to starboard.

At the stern, the carpeted cockpit has a full width upholstered bench seat and backrest, with stowage space underneath. To create even more entertaining and living space, the saloon dining table is specially designed so that it can be quickly and securely installed in front of the seat, and just as easily replaced in its original position when required.

Six foot headroom down below makes living aboard a pleasure, even for tall people. Curtained and carpeted throughout, the accommodation has been planned for maximum convenience combined with virtually all the comforts of home.


To starboard aft there's an enclosed, self-contained toilet, wash basin and shower with bot and cold pressurised water. Amidships, a gas over with grill and two burners, stainless steel sink/drainer with hot and cold water, electric refrigerator and sensible stowage space for galley utensils, crockery, glasses and cutlery—and generous work surfaces. Opposite, you'll find a roomy, deep-cushioned dinette area with a large table, which quickly converts to a double berth.

To make life even more comfortable, there's a hanging locker, drinks cupboard, and plenty of extra drawers and cupboards. We ve even fitted a 12 volt TV socket and electric shaver point.


Up forward, there are two individual berths, which also have additional storage space underneath.

All interior joinery is in teak, and to ensure it's up to our exacting standards we make the furniture ourselves.

- 1 Helmsman's seat and passenger/lookout seat.
- 2 Looking aft-note the large non-slip coach roof deck, and big windows.
- Wide, non-slip side decks. Engine air intakes are discreetly hidden behind two-tone panels.
- Salcon dining table is easily fitted in the cockpit to make an extra entertainment area.
- Big galley area, complete with gas oven, grill and burners, stainless steel sink/drainer with hot and cold water, electric refrigerator, cupboards and drawers.

Electric refrigerator, 12 volt TV socker and shaver point. Hanging cupboard, drinks cupboard, tumbler rack, crockery storage, drawers and cupboards. Carpets, cushions and curains. Plastic laminate covered work surfaces including saloon table.
