Our first metric Seamaster provides an attractive alternative to the Seamaster 27. It combines comfortable living accommodation with exciting performance easily handled from a centre cockpit. The powerful hull and superstructure are of G.R.P.

The aft 'Great Cabin'

This is the main living accommodation. And every inch of space afforded by the 10′5″ beam is thoughtfully used. There is a fully-equipped galley which could be the envy of many a shore kitchen. A stainless steel sink, 2-burner cocker with grill and oven, plenty of wipe-clean working surfaces and lockers to stow away utensils and equipment. There is a hanging locker too. The table for the dinette use is strong yet light—suitable for a growing family. For sleeping there is a double berth. And—a final touch of luxury, a cocktail cabinet for entertaining.

The fore cabin

Again a generous cabin which contains two single sleeping berths. They can be shut off from access to the toilet on the starboard side, which also contains its own wash-hand basin and mirror, and the hanging cupboards on the port side for complete privacy. Both the fore and aft 'Great Cabin' are carpeted and curtained throughout and have 6' headroom.


The centre cockpit

The comfortable helmsman seat has all controls immediately at hand on a console in front of you. Surrounding the forward end of this cockpit is a toughened glass spray screen, which can be enclosed by a hood in inclement weather.

Your choice of engines

Single or twin Ford 1600 cc engines converted by Wortham Blake, Alternatively Perkins 4:107 diesel engines.
All these engines have hydraulic gearboxes and single lever control which is operated from the dash board.
