Spacious cruising: The Shadow 26 can sleep up to six in comfort and privacy – remarkable for a boat of this size. In fact, at 26'4" LOA, she has all the spaciousness of a 30-footer.

The forward area makes a restful saloon, or can be used as

a dining area. Later, when guests wish to relax and enjoy the passing seascape, they can move to the aft area of the saloon, sinking back into the softly cushioned seating around the coffee table in a friendly and convivial atmosphere.

The cabin opens out, right from stem to stern, integrating even the cockpit into a single, superb family living area. Come nightfall, though, privacy is assured; just close off the cabin and you have a room for four people in two private cabins. You

can also slide over the bench in the cockpit to create an additional double berth, shielded from the night sky by an awning. (You'll find this berth in particular demand, because come morning the lucky occupants will be able to roll back the awning and luxuriate in the warm sunshine.)

All this, on a nullform that provides a solid, secure and remarkably responsive ride.
